W-F YOUTH GIRLS BASKETBALL

Dear Parents and Players,

We are very excited for another great year of youth girls basketball! We run a very positive and fun youth program that teaches basketball skills, self discipline, accountability, team work and **fun**.

We are currently forming our 3rd, 4th, 5th, and 6th grade teams. We also have 7th and 8th grade teams. This year we will be starting a 2nd grade Introduction to Basketball. Our youth program is open to all students that live in the W-F School District regardless of the school they attend. We encourage anyone interested in playing to join regardless of experience. We have a lot of players that have not played before. We only ask that the players and parents have a good attitude and have a **strong commitment**.

2nd Grade Girls Basketball

2nd Grade Girls Introductory Basketball - The 2nd-grade program is designed to introduce young players to the game of basketball. The program will allow the children to learn the basic skills in a fun, fast paced atmosphere. The program runs for 6 weeks and will be conducted by former varsity Coach Joe Titus. Girls Varsity players will also assist when available. The first 3 sessions of the program will consist of basic skills to give your player an understanding of the game of basketball. Each of the last 3 sessions will start with basic skills and will end with games of 3-on-3.

Practice - Usually there are at least 1-2 practices per week at one of the gyms in Weyauwega. Specific dates and times will be determined and a schedule provided by your team's coach. Each practice will be one hour long.

Player fees

\$20.00 - We try to keep the fees as low as possible, so we can have as many kids participate as possible. Included in the fee is a basketball for every player!

Tournaments/Games - Since there are not many other programs in the area that have 2nd grade programs the bulk of our competition will come from within the team with 3-on-3 play. We will be seeking out other programs to see if they have teams for play.

Required equipment:

- Basketball/athletic shoes - Street shoes are not allowed on the gym floor.
- Red/Black athletic shorts
- Head bands and hair ties - players hair must be kept up and out of line of sight.

No earrings, jewelry, or bobby pins are allowed to be worn at practice or games.



3rd, 4th, 5th, and 6th grade teams - will play on Saturdays, January through March. They will play 4 to 6 weekends during this timeframe. Usually we will host 1 tourney per grade and the rest will be on the road within about 40 miles of W-F. Practice will begin in December. We usually get the entire program in one Wi Dells tourney in Feb or March if players and parents are interested.

Attention 3rd grade parents and prospective players. Almost all of our 3rd graders have not played basketball before and **that is ok**. We have a very positive program and they will love it once they get over the nerves of starting something new. Our 3rd graders from last year loved it and didn't want the season to end. It will be a positive experience for them.

7th and 8th grade teams - will play on Saturdays, November through the first weekend in January. They will play in 4 to 6 tournaments during this timeframe. Practice will begin in October. We will usually host 1 tourney per grade and the rest will be on the road usually within about 60 miles of W-F. We get the entire program in one Wi Dells tourney in Feb or March if players and parents are interested.

Practice – Usually there are at least 2 - 3 practices per week at one of the gyms in Weyauwega. Specific dates and times will be determined and a schedule provided by your team's coach.

Player fees

\$25.00 - For returning players that have their reversible jersey from last year, it is in good condition, and it still fits. They must have all letters, numbers intact, and look decent.

\$40.00 - For all new players and returning players that need a new jersey.

We try to keep the fees as low as possible. The fees cover reversible jerseys and a portion of the tournament entry costs. The rest of the costs are covered by the money we make when we host tournaments.

Tournament hosting – Each grade will usually host one Saturday tournament at W-F. We will need **all parents** to help with set up, concessions, and clean up at their player's tournament. This is our only fundraiser and allows us to keep player fees down so please plan on helping. Set up for tourneys starts at 7am and we are usually done by 6pm.

Required equipment:

- Basketball shoes - Street shoes are not allowed on the gym floor.
- Red basketball shorts
- Head bands and hair ties – players hair must be kept up and out of line of sight.

No earrings, jewelry, or bobby pins are allowed to be worn at practice or games.
