The National Education Association (NEA) has dedicated March 2 as "Read Across America" Day. It is a campaign to motivate young readers and raise awareness of books and reading. March 2 is Dr. Seuss' Birthday, the well-known author of many children's books. Dr. Seuss' real name is Theodor Seuss Geisel. During his career he wrote more than 40 children's books! We will be celebrating the love of reading this week! Below is some information about what we will be doing at Fremont for "Read Across America" week!
